Sustainability:

The composite core is mainly made up of crushed stone, and with 1.5mm IXEP backing. For our commercial grade the top layers are virgin material for durability. **Waterproof, Fireproof and Formaldehyde Free Flooring.**

With our forests ever decreasing and precious resources being used for an increasing market in wood flooring, we have an alternative that uses less of our natural forests.

Impervia Luxury Flooring is extruded from natural elements and stone. The decorative layer is made from high quality photographic paper and our acoustic backing is VOC free with no cryogenic emissions or formaldehyde.

The finish has a ceramic quality for high traffic areas.

The IPXE backing has an acoustic property of 21dB.

The total thickness is 6.5mm and it requires no adhesive or other accessories or material to fit.

Manufacturing: Impervia floors are manufactured using the latest extrusion technology where the protective top layer, decorative layer and composite centre core are extruded as one fusing them together to create a natural looking surface and in accordance with accepted industry standards, which permit a tolerance not to exceed 5%. The variations may be of a manufacturing or natural type (this does not include colour variation). The surface is then finished on a UV line after been pressed to create the textured surface.

Samples: Small samples will give a representative example of the colour of the finished floor. However, to mimic the appearance of natural wood or stone one small sample WILL NOT be representative of the overall effect of an Impervia™ floor. Therefore, should it be necessary to gain a better understanding of how a larger area will look, purchasing cartons for a sample area should be considered, before making a final decision.

Storage: See Impervia Storage Fitting and Maintenance Instructions part of our T&C's

In order to minimise potential damages, it is advisable to store Impervia flooring away from wet trades or building works and to have such works completed prior to installation of the floor.

Fixing: See Impervia Storage Fitting and Maintenance Instructions part of our T&C's

The composite flooring we produce uses the latest Valinge push fit technology so it is very easy to install due to its stability in not being affected by moisture.

NBS:

NBS specifications can be written by request once we have full details of the subfloor build up.

Cleaning: See Impervia Storage Fitting and Maintenance Instructions as per our T&C's

(never use solvent cleaning solution) Correct cleaning and maintenance is important. Impervia can use antibacterial cleaners, steam mops etc... be sure to <u>avoid</u> enamel cleaners or strong solvents that may weaken the ceramic lacquer finish.

Never build onto a stone composite floor: Impervia Luxury plank flooring doesn't provide a good foundation to build onto. Therefore, it is important to design any cabinets and internal furniture with their own structural base and not to be sat on the stone composite flooring, so that should any damage occur, the floor finish can be easily repaired or removed.
