



WHAT ARE BISCUIT JOINTS

We are asked on numerous occasions what biscuit joints are and when they are used.

These types of joints are used where you have boards that have been cut like the one below so that when you put the next board up to it the biscuit joint will go into both grooves.

They are commonly used where you need to change the direction of boards or where specialist designs like the Mansion Weave are made up of small pieces individually machined to create a unique pattern. The biscuit joints are easily obtained from any good timber merchant.
